Halifax County COVID-19 Vaccine Update

Halifax – Halifax County Health Department, Drugco Pharmacy and Rural Health Group are now taking **FIRST DOSE** appointments by **online registration only** for the following groups:

Group 1 includes:

- Health care workers caring for and working directly with patients with COVID-19, including staff responsible for cleaning and maintenance in those areas
- Health care workers administering the vaccine
- Long-term care staff and residents – people in skilled nursing facilities and in adult, family and group homes.

Group 2 includes:

- Anyone **65 years and older**, regardless of health status or living situation

Group 3A:

- School employees and child care workers

Halifax County Health Department will offer **FIRST DOSE** appointments by **online registration only** for Thursday, February 25, 2021 and Friday, February 26, 2021 from 8:30am - 4:00pm in Weldon, NC at Halifax Community College Building 700. You **MUST** enter Halifax Community College via the Country Club Road entrance. Please follow the signs posted to direct you to the 700 Building. Please be advised that anyone who has a scheduled appointment will receive a call from the health department to pre-register you for your vaccine.
