PERRY NAMED DEPUTY COUNTY MANAGER

Halifax, NC – After an extensive recruitment and interview process, County Manager Dia H. Denton announced that Renee Perry, currently Halifax County’s Human Resources Management (HRM) Director, has been named Deputy County Manager, effective June 15, 2022.

Perry first came to Halifax County as HRM Director in October 2018, serving in that position for more than two years. She moved to Rockingham County as the Director of Human Resources and Risk Management from April 2020 to June 2021, while still serving Halifax County’s HRM department on a contractual basis. She returned to Halifax County as HRM Director in July 2021. Perry has worked in local government for 16 years, including time spent early in her career working for Guilford County and the City of Greensboro.
